

2006 DE LANCELLOTTI ESTATE PINOT NOIR CHEHALEM MOUNTAINS A.V.A.

The 2006 de Lancellotti family vineyard Pinot Noir is a blend of selections from the Pommard clone and Dijon 115 clone within Laurens Block. Aged for eighteen months in French oak cooperage without racking,

This wine has a dark burgundy color with tints of violet. Very sweet floral nose with rich spice notes of cinnamon, vanilla, clove and the dark ripe fruits of blackberry and black cherry with light barrel toast.

Big fruit profile on the front of the palate with sweet high toned dark raspberry and cherry flavors. Very juicy fruits and oak spice lead to a long finish framed by good integrated tannins and mouthwatering acidity.
