



2006 NYSA VINEYARD PINOT NOIR



Tasting Notes:

What a great year for the Nysa Vineyard. This high-elevation vineyard produced low yields once again in 2006 and the long hot summer ripened the fruit to perfection which let us pick when we wanted, at full physiological ripeness.

This wine is a sensual experience that is all about elegance and texture. The wine has a dark ruby hue and a very floral/berry perfume which is telltale of it's Dundee Hills origins. These red volcanic soils yield powerful wines of great elegance and this is no exception.

Full of rich, ripe red berry and black raspberry and cherry notes, this wine is silky on the palate with a long fine-textured finish showing the warm and generous ripeness levels of the 2006 vintage.

Drink this wine now through 2012 with local salmon or trout dishes and even a fine cut of steak.
